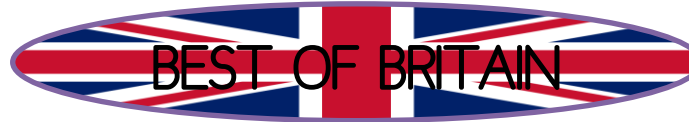
Healthy Schools
