



Top Tips

Challenge 1	Use items at home to make the above display of number bonds to 10. It could be paper chains or counters. Use your imagination.
Challenge 2	Use practical resources to solve word problems. I have 6 sweets, how many more sweets will I need to make 7 sweets in total? I have 6 cars, how many cars will I have if I take away 3?
Challenge 3	You can play games online at https://ictgames.com/saveTheWhale/index.html and then see how many questions you can answer.
Challenge 4	Can you make a poster displaying the ways you can make 7? You could draw pictures and visuals to help you remember them!
Challenge 5	Get a grown up to give you some number bonds to 10 questions. How many can you get right? You could do this on a car journey, on a walk in the park or just at home!
Challenge 6	Use things found in nature to make the number 9. For example, 4 sticks and 5 stones to make 9. 3 leaves and 6 conkers to make 9.
