

Key Instant Recall Facts Nursery - Summer 2

I can recognise numerals 1-5.

It is expected that children in Nursery will recognise some numbers of personal significance, such as their own age, as well as recognising numerals 1-5.

You could try some of these ideas...

Go on a Number Hunt

Let's go on a number hunt! What numbers can you find around your home; do you recognise them? You may find numbers on the clock, the cooker or the remote control. You could extend your number hunt to going outside; what numbers can you see? Do you recognise any numbers on the car number plates? Practise saying the number names to your grown-up.

Number Songs

Make some number flashcards with numerals 1-5. Sing some counting songs and hold up the correct number card for each verse. You could sing 5 Little Speckled Frogs, 5 Little Ducks or 5 Little Monkeys!

Key Vocabulary

What number is this? Can you find number 2? Where is number 3? What numbers can we find?

Decorating Numbers

Ask your grown-up to write some large numerals for you. Practise saying the number names to your grown-up. You could have fun decorating the numbers in lots of different ways; sticking on collage, tracing over with paint, fingerprints, covering with natural objects such as leaves and flowers. You could display your decorated numbers around your home to practise recognising them!
