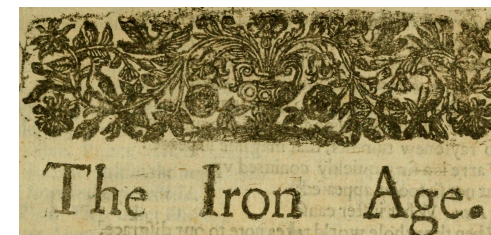
## SCIENCE AND COMPUTING
