## I know doubles of numbers to 5.

Pupils should be able to quickly recall the doubles of all numbers to 5

$$1+1 = 2 \quad 3+3 = 6 \quad 5+5 = 10$$

$$2+2 = 4 \quad 4+4 = 8$$






### Your home learning this half term...

<p>Challenge 1: Counting favourite items</p> 	<p>Use objects that your little one is interested in and count them into 2 groups of 1,2,3,4 or 5. E.g sweets, cars, rubbers. Make sure the number of Objects in each group is the same!</p>
<p>Challenge 2: Creative activities</p> 	<p>Draw or paint pictures of butterflies, ladybirds and other items that show a pair of numbers. You could paint ladybird spots on 1 wing and then fold the paper to reveal the double!</p>
<p>Challenge 3: Dice Doubles</p> 	<p>Roll a dice and put that many cubes in one pile, then make an identical pile, adding them together.</p>
<p>Challenge 4: Mirror Doubles</p> 	<p>Place toys in front of a mirror to see the double reflection, or use mirrors to double the number of bricks in a tower.</p>
<p>Challenge 5: Finger Doubles</p> 	<p>Children hold up fingers on one hand, then show the same number on the other hand to see the total.</p>
<p>Challenge 6: Reception Doubles ICT</p> 	<p>Learn doubles by playing this Reception Doubling Game. Count the amounts shown, work out the double and drag the correct answer into the box.
