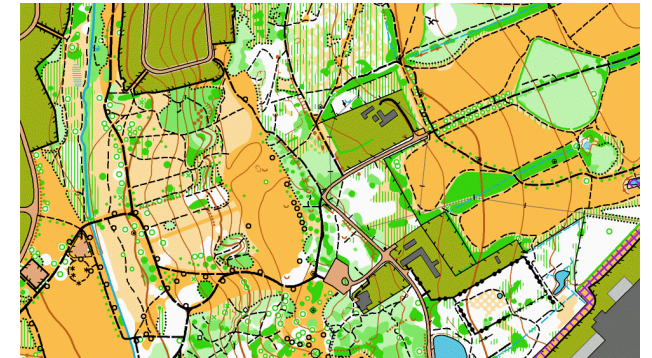
SCIENCE AND COMPUTING

- Grouping and Sorting



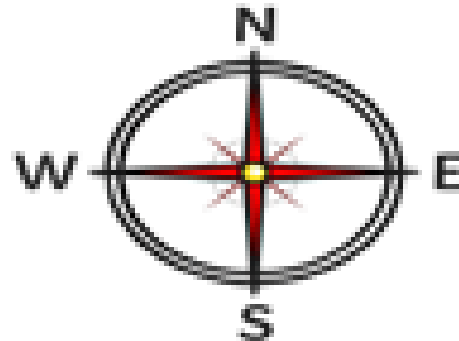
ENGLISH
