Year 2

Make a doctor's stethoscope



What you need

- Kitchen roll tube
- Gaffer tape/ Duct tape
- Small funnel

What to do

1. Tape the funnel to one end of the kitchen roll.
2. Listen to a friend's chest.
3. Can you hear their heart beating?
4. Count how many beats in 1 minute.
5. Predict what would happen if they did some star jumps for 1 minute.
6. Count the number of beats after the exercise.
7. Record your answers. What do you notice?
8. Repeat with another form of exercise of your choice; record the beats before 1 minute of exercise and then record how many after.

What is happening?

When you exercise, your body needs more energy. Your heart beats faster so that you have more oxygen around your body.
