Experiment

Investigate how the Ancient Egyptians preserved bodies using fruit!

Wrap an apple slice in paper towel and place it in a container covered with salt or bicarbonate of soda. Check daily for two weeks and record any observations.



Explore

Use an atlas, map, or online map to explore the River Nile.



Identify key features: deserts, floodplains, major cities, and where pyramids were built.
