### Your Home learning this half term...

Challenge 1: Practical activity	Give your child a multiplication problem, e.g., 6x2. They must create 6 groups of 2 items each using bowls/plates and objects. They then count the total to find the answer (12).
Challenge 2: Practical activity	Give your child a total number of objects that is a multiple of two, e.g., 16. Ask them to divide the objects into groups of twos and count how many groups they made. (Alternatively, ask them to divide the 16 objects into 2 equal groups and count how many are in each group).
Challenge 3: Increasing fluency	Play hit the button - 2 times tables <a href="https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/hit-the-button">https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/hit-the-button</a>
Challenge 4: Increasing accuracy	Complete all 2 times table challenge on times table rockstars
Challenge 5: Problem solving	<b>Packs of Pencils:</b> Mrs. Smith buys 9 packs of pencils for the classroom. Each pack has 2 pencils. How many pencils does she have altogether? <b>Money:</b> Tom saves £2 every week. How much money will he have saved after 5 weeks? Can you create your own 2x calculation stories?
Challenge 6: Reasoning	<b>True or false statements:</b> "If I have 18 biscuits and I divide them into groups of 2 there will be 9 bags" "When you divide a number by 2 the answer will always be an even number" "When you multiply a number by 2 the answer is always bigger than the number you started with"
