





<p><b>Inference</b> is when you read between the lines and look for clues in a story.</p> <p><b>Children choose one correct answer.</b></p> <p>Does the sunshine suggest it is hot or cold?</p> <p><b>Circle the correct answer.</b></p> <p><i>Hot</i></p> <p><i>Cold</i></p>	<p>A <b>Prediction</b> is a statement that someone makes about what they think is going to happen.</p> <p>What do you think will happen in this story?</p> <p>Who do you think will win the race?</p> <p>What do you think is going to be the next thing that happens?</p>	<p><b>Retrieval</b> is when you have to pick out information from a text in order to answer questions about it.</p> <p><b>Children will be asked to remember information from the story they have read.</b></p> <p>What did Sam do in the park?</p> <p>Where was the dog living?</p> <p>Which character was Billy's sister?</p> <p>How many babies were in the story?</p> <p>How many people were there at the party?</p> <p>Which party food was Sam's favourite?</p> <p>Why was there a party?</p> <p>How many candles were on the cake?</p>	<p><b>Summarising</b> means recalling the main points or ideas.</p> <p>Children will be asked to summarise and recall events.</p> <p>What happened in the story?</p> <p>What happened at the fair?</p>	<p>Reading <b>Vocabulary</b> refers to the words we need to know to understand what we read.</p> <p><b>Find</b> a word in the story which describes how Tom is feeling.</p> <p><b>Find</b> a word in the story which describes how Tom is acting.</p> <p><b>Find</b> a word in the story which describes how Tom looks.</p> <p><b>Find</b> a word in the story which describes how old Tom is.</p>
