Help Your Child with English and maths (2 hours a week/10 weeks)

For caregivers of children in Foundation Stage and Key Stage 1, birth to 7

- focus on both literacy and numeracy
- spend time making resources
- guide parents to support children through exploring rhythm and rhyme
- sharing books and games and create own learning resources.



Keeping Up with the Children (2 hours a week/10/12 weeks)

For caregivers of children in Key Stage 2 , 7-11 years old

- split into two separate 5 or 6 week parts (English and maths)
- explains some of the key skills which children need to develop and allows parents to explore ways in which they can support children in reading, writing and maths
- parents have opportunity to develop their own skills in topics such as sentence construction, punctuation and fractions to improve confidence and knowledge.

Grammar for Parents (2 hours a week/5 weeks)

For caregivers of children in Y1 - Y6

- explains and helps parents to understand the grammar their child is learning in English lessons
- builds parents' confidence in supporting their children's learning

Make a Story Sack (2 hours a week/5 weeks)

For caregivers of children in Foundation stage, birth to 5



- Parents choose a book/story to make assorted resources for, to share with their child and develop literacy and numeracy skills and knowledge. It provides opportunities for parents/carers to encourage their children to communicate verbally and to develop skills through play that will be important later for reading, writing and maths. It acknowledges the unique role that parents/carers have in their children's language development and the importance of the family and home as a powerful learning environment alongside school or nursery.
- This is an adult-only programme. However, the college can supply childcare workers to run a free crèche for pre-school children, providing that a suitable room is available.
