English

Text Focus: Wild Robot by Peter Brown

- Understand the language, structure and presentation features of adventure and mystery stories.
- Use text features to create suspense in adventure and mystery stories.
- Create poems based on the characters from the text.
- Extend the range of sentences with more than one clause by using a wide range of conjunctions e.g. when, if, because, although.
- Use speech marks correctly to show what has been said.
- Use synonyms for said.

Maths

Key Instant Recall Fact: I know my 9 and 11 times tables.

Measurement: Length and Perimeter

- Measure in metres, cm and mm.
- Add and subtract lengths.
- Measure the perimeter of shapes.

Number: Multiplication and division

- Multiply and divide by 1, 10 and 100.
- Recall 3, 6, 9 and 7 times tables and corresponding division facts.

Decimals

- Tenths and hundredths.
- Linking division with tenths and hundredths.

- Make and test simple circuits
- Investigate what is a good conductor of electricity
