### English

In English we will be looking at two texts 'Lila and the Secret of Rain' and 'One day on our Blue planet: In Savannah'. We will be writing a retell and a Factfile. The grammar focus will be:

- Using **because, also, and, so...** and how these are used to elaborate sentences.
- Using a capital letter for names of people, places, the days of the week, and the personal pronoun *I*.
- Using exclamations for impact e.g. **It's amazing!**
- Using the spelling rule for adding *-s* or *-es* as the plural marker for nouns.
- Using the suffixes *-ing, -ed, -er* and *-est* where no change is needed in the spelling of root words.
- Using the prefix *un*.

**Key Instant Recall Facts**— I know doubles of all numbers to 10 and halves of all even numbers to 10.

#### Measurement: Length and Height

- comparing length and heights
