

# Key Instant Recall Facts Reception – Autumn 2



## I can subitise to 5.

It is expected that children in Reception will be able to subitise numbers up to 5. Subitising is when you are able to look at a group of objects and realise how many there are without counting. This only works with small groups of numbers up to 5.

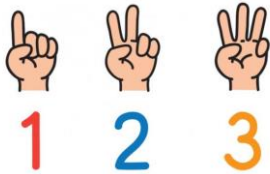

### You could try some of these ideas...



Bunny ears

Show a number of fingers above your head like bunny ears. Ask your child how many? Can they show you the same number using their bunny ears?

### Board Games

Using board games with dice is a fun way to develop children's subitising ability without them even realising. Children roll the dice and say how many without counting.

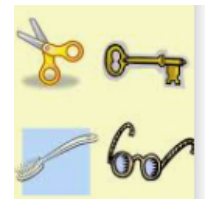


Dominoes

Using a set of dominoes, match the dots on each domino. How quick can you match all the dominoes?

### Memory games

Have a selection of objects on the floor covered over with a towel. Remove the towel for a very short time. Ask your child how many did they see. If they are right, they get a point. Change the amount of objects and repeat. When they reach 5 points, they have won!
