I aspire to tell the time to the nearest 5 minute intervals.

Children need to be able to tell the time using a clock with hands and converting to digital time.

This target can be broken down into several steps.

- I can tell the time to the nearest hour. (00)
- I can tell the time to the nearest half hour. (30)
- I can tell the time to the nearest quarter of an hour. (15 and 45)
- I can tell the time to the nearest five minutes. (05)

The secret to success is practising little and often. If you would like more ideas, please speak to your child's teacher.

You could try some of these activities....

Add labels to a clock at home - print off the labels on the next page and blu tack them around a clock to help with remembering the times.

Make a clock – print off the clock template attached to this sheet and make a clock to practise with. If you need a split pin to allow the hands to move, please ask your child's teacher.
