- A: Name and define 3 Ancient Greece Olympic Games events.
- B: Write a description of a mythical creature from Ancient Greece using expanded noun phrases with powerful adjectives.
- C: Turn a Greek Myth into a cartoon story board with lots of speech bubbles

North America (SMSC)

- A : Children from the age of 7 were trained to join the Spartan army. Write about how you would feel and cope with this.
- B: Research a Greek God or Goddess and create a fact file. How are these different to the Roman Gods?
- C: Find out how the lives of women living in Sparta and Athens were different.

Asia (Personal Development)

- A: Research and design your own Bouzouki (a musical instrument popular in Greece).
- B: Use outdoor materials to design and make your own Trojan Horse.
- C: Use PowerPoint or presentation software to create a tour guide to current day Greece.

Antarctica (Topic: Geography & DT)

- A: Label the Greek islands on a map of Europe.
- B: Create a holiday brochure to modern day Greece. Include information about different geographical features they could visit.
- C: Design and create a mask that could be used for Greek plays. Think about the emotions that your mask is portraying.

Africa (Maths)

- A: Find the dates of 5 key events in Ancient Greece.
- B: Research Archimedes and explain what mathematical discovery he made.
- C: Create an Ancient Greek Maths quiz - involve the number system, Greek calendar and key dates.

South America (Healthy Schools)

- A: Find out about an Olympic sport and take a picture of yourself trying it out.
- B: Research fabrics worn for different Olympic events. Why is the fabric used suitable?
- C: Create your own Olympic event and get your family members to try. Investigate how your heart rate changes. Whose pulse rate increases the most?

Australasia (Topic: Art & Design and History)

- A: Investigate the importance of stars in ancient Greek culture and discover your zodiac sign, symbols and attributes.
- B: Investigate the battle of marathons and timeline the key events, explaining how it has impacted our lives today.
- C: Design and make a Greek pot, ensuring it tells the story of a famous myth in traditional Greek style.
